### Prize Giving

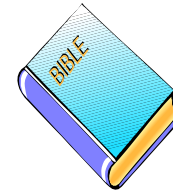
You will be presented with a book at a special Service in June.

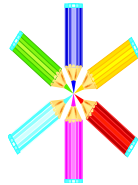

## Collection on Sunday morning?
